UTA FORT WORTH

Located downtown since 2007 in the historic Santa Fe Freight Depot, UTA Fort Worth offers accelerated bachelor's and master's degree programs, individual courses, and professional development opportunities in an intimate learning environment that features smaller class sizes and an innovative, lock-step cohort delivery model. Programs include undergraduate degrees in social work and nursing and graduate degrees in business, health care administration, engineering, real estate, and social work.

TARRANT TO AND THROUGH (T3)

The UTA and T3 partnership provides Fort Worth ISD high school students with personalized guidance, programming, and even funding opportunities to help them achieve a college education. UTA enrolls the largest cohort of first-time students among the T3 four-year university partner institutions.





HEALTH CARE PIPELINE

As the largest producer of baccalaureate-educated nurses in Texas, UTA's College of Nursing and Health Innovation has connections to more than 180 clinical sites, including JPS Health Network, Cook Children's Medical Center, Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital, Baylor, Scott & White All Saints Medical Center, and ACH Child and Family Services. Thanks to these partnerships, more than 1,000 nursing and social work students complete clinical rotations and field work annually in Fort Worth.

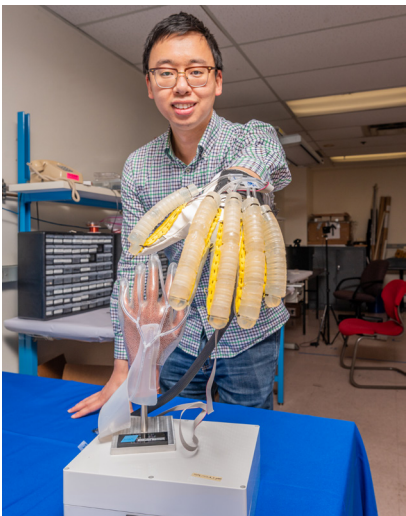
