



**T**he Honors College at UT Arlington is a tight-knit community dedicated to fostering academic and personal growth.

Within this **supportive environment**, students uplift one another while receiving **guidance and encouragement** from staff, faculty, and professors alike.

The Honors College offers students opportunities to **enhance their leadership abilities** through four student organizations: the **Honors College Council**, which organizes diverse social and academic activities; the **Honors College Advocates**, which represent the college at UTA by hosting events and serving as official representatives; the **Programming Board**, which coordinates approximately 30 student events each semester; and the **Veneratio newsletter**, which is produced by Honors College students and distributed once per semester.



## 2023-24 SNAPSHOT

- More than **495 new Honors** students admitted, for a **total enrollment of 950**.
- **31 students** participated in the Honors Residential Learning Community in Vandergriff Hall, the largest cohort ever.
- Over **95 scholarship recipients** were awarded more than **\$200,000**.
- **82 students presented Captone research** across various disciplines at the Honors Research Symposium, with several participating in undergraduate research fellowships on campus.
